

## Sustainability initiatives at mesm Tokyo

Since its opening in 2020, mesm Tokyo has aimed to be an environmentally and socially sustainable hotel. As we are located by the waterside in Takeshiba, we are committed to coexistence with nature and actively engage in conservation activities. We sincerely hope that all of our guests will support our efforts.

### Consideration for Resources

- To reduce the environmental impact, the air conditioning settings in the hotel are set to 24°C for cooling and 22°C for heating as a standard. We kindly ask for your understanding.

- The bathrobes and towels provided in the rooms are made from highly absorbent and quick-drying materials. Compared to standard hotel towels, they are lighter, more convenient, and also help conserve water during washing. Additionally, the tap water in the rooms is safe and delicious to drink, just like the bottled water in the refrigerator.

- To reduce paper consumption, all hotel information and policies are available on the tablet provided in your room. If you have any questions about how to use it, please contact Star Service.

### Eco-Friendly Amenities

To reduce waste, bath amenities (shampoo, conditioner, body wash), hand soap, and body lotion are provided in refillable dispenser bottles. The amenity boxes are made from recyclable paper and biodegradable plastic.

### Environmentally Conscious Supplies

The beverages in the room's refrigerator are provided in easily recyclable paper packs, aluminum cans, and glass bottles. In addition to disposable slippers, we also provide sanitized rubber-soled sandals, which are comfortable to wear, and we encourage you to try them.

### Low Carbon Food Sourcing

To reduce carbon dioxide emissions, we source ingredients from within a 100-kilometer radius whenever possible. The fresh vegetables from the Tokyo area are highly nutritious and contribute to your well-being.

### Low Carbon Transportation Options

The hydrogen shuttle bus (fuel cell bus) from mesm Tokyo to Tokyo Station is a convenient, environmentally friendly option. This bus service is part of the "Zero Carbon Challenge 2050," which aims for net-zero CO2 emissions, and circulates between Hamamatsucho Station and Tokyo Station. ### Gender-Neutral Initiatives

To accommodate diverse gender identities, all staff members wear the same gender-neutral uniforms designed by Yohji Yamamoto. This contributes to creating a comfortable working environment and promoting gender equality.
